

## Coxswain

### Responsible to the Chief Mate.

#### **Responsibilities attributed to the Coxswain position include, but are not limited to:**

- i)** Taking charge and command of Rescue Craft and her crew upon launch, subject to Masters orders.
- ii)** General upkeep and local repairs of Fast Rescue Craft / Daughter Craft.
- iii)** Running up F.R.C. Engines to ensure they operate (Using muffs if F.R.C. cannot be launched).
- iv)** Reporting all FRC / DC defects to the Chief Engineer and Master, and liaising with both regarding general upkeep of craft.
- v)** General on deck daytime duties, as directed by the Chief Mate.
- vi)** The Coxswain must also be familiar with all fire fighting appliances on board, locations of shut down switches for accommodation fans, etc.
- vii)** Coxswain will form part of the vessel fire fighting team, and should be familiar with the correct procedures for application and use of various types of breathing apparatus, whereby applicable. For example: Bellows Sets, Compressed Air Breathing Apparatus and Emergency Escape breathing devices.
- viii)** Monitoring safe working practices of shore contractors during periods of maintenance.
- ix)** Actively promoting and progressing the company Quality, Health, Safety and Environmental Policy.
- x)** Actively promoting inter-departmental communications.



**xi) Stop the job when required.**

**xii) Ensuring all personal original certification is on board and valid when sailing including ENG1, CoC, UK CEC (where applicable) and STCW95 and OPITO. This must also include a valid passport.**

**xiii) Reporting any illness or injury to crewing agent that may affect his capacity on joining.**
