

Deckhands

Responsible to the Chief Mate.

Duties ascribed to the Deckhand position include, but are not limited to:

- i) The execution of duties as designated by watch keeping rota. Deckhand is responsible to the Watch Keeping Officer on Watch for any / all duties.
- ii) Responsible to the Coxswain when engaged as a Rescue Craft crew member.
- iii) Deckhands should be familiar with the use of Breathing Apparatus and possess basic Fire Fighting Skills.
- iv) Forming part of both the vessel's on board Emergency Response team, and Rescue Craft's whereby applicable.
- v) Monitoring safe working practices of shore contractors during periods of maintenance
- vi) Actively promoting and progressing the company Quality, Health, Safety and Environmental Policy.
- vii) Actively promoting inter-departmental communications.
- viii) [Stop the job](#) when required
- ix) Ensuring all personal original certification is on board and valid when sailing including ENG1, CoC and STCW95 and OPITO. This must also include a valid passport.
- x) Reporting any illness or injury to crewing agent that may affect his capacity on joining.

AMA will also have the added responsibility of being responsible for all Medical Aid and supplies onboard the vessel and in any emergency.
